Her parents already had a fashion store in Bludenz from the early 1980s to the early 2000s. Her father, Kurt Leidinger, a musician and entrepreneur, often took her to fashion fairs, where she had to do her homework, study for school and, of course, learn a lot of important things for life. The idea for her company came to her together with her daughter. The two horse lovers always need things for training, so they started making their own ropes. What can the people of Bludenz expect? NODO means knot in Italian. In order to be sustainable, we also used leftovers, first creating the knotted halter and the ground work rope, then quickly adding key rings, rope bracelets and dog leads. Knot after knot, so to speak. Tanya also likes to "knot" artists and craftspeople. Each of these networks is organized as a separate opening in the pop-up store and so she started this November at the first opening with her own NODO designed & predominantly handmade products from Vorarlberg. These will then be offered as exclusive accessories and jewelry in December from 11 to 21 December.
